Honoring the rich, multicultural history of El Pueblo de Abiquiú

El Pueblo de Abiquiú was established in 1754 as a land grant settlement for thirty-four Genízaro families. Genízaros are Native peoples of diverse tribal heritages who were forcibly assimilated and detribalized under Spanish colonization.

Though their origins were shaped by displacement and violence, the descendants of the Genízaros of El Pueblo de Abiquiú have cultivated a resilient and enduring community deeply rooted in the land and cultural survival. The name Abiquiú comes from the Tewa word for "wild chokecherry place."

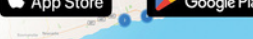

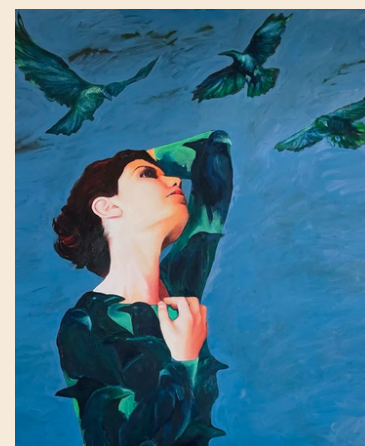
